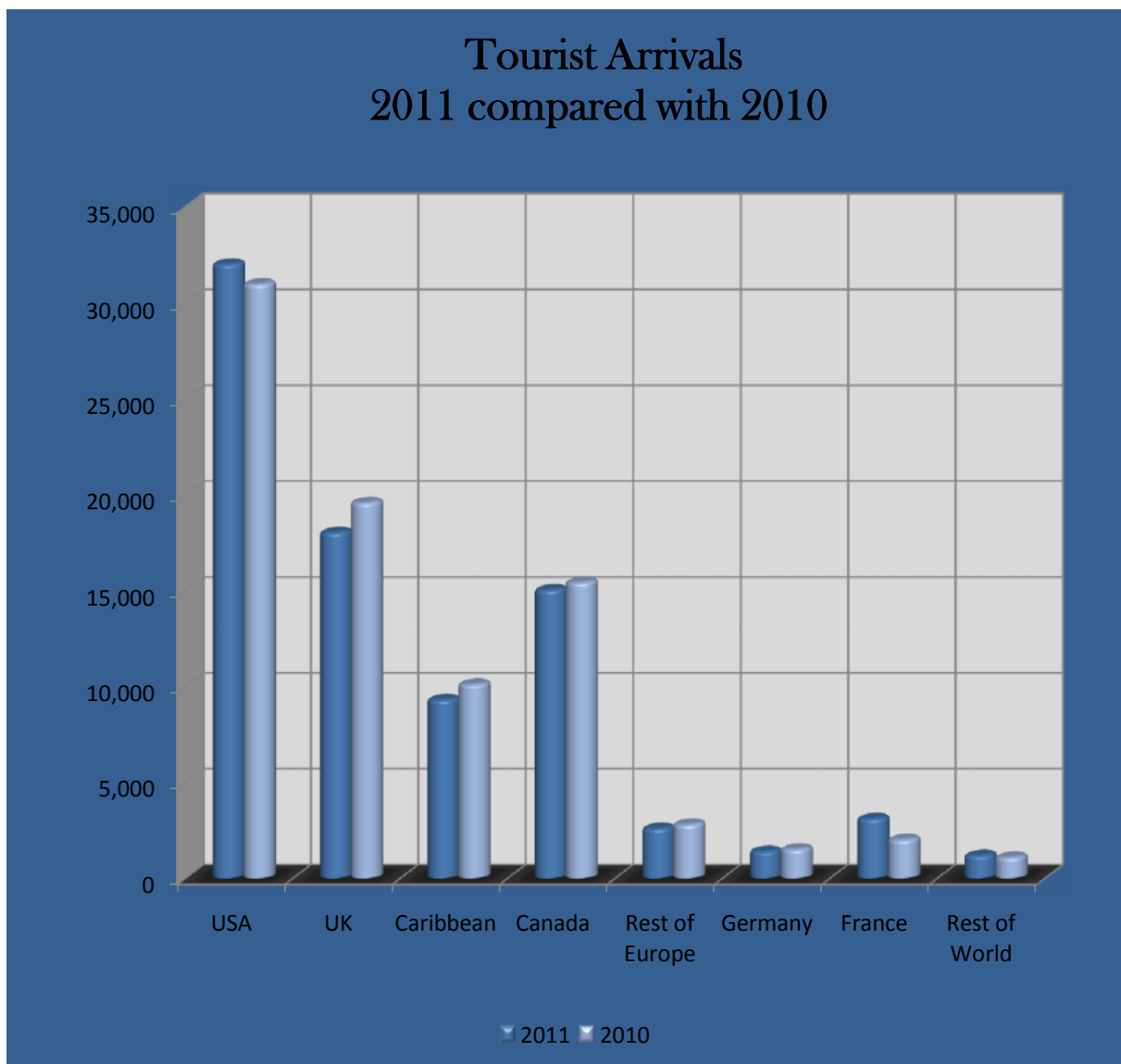

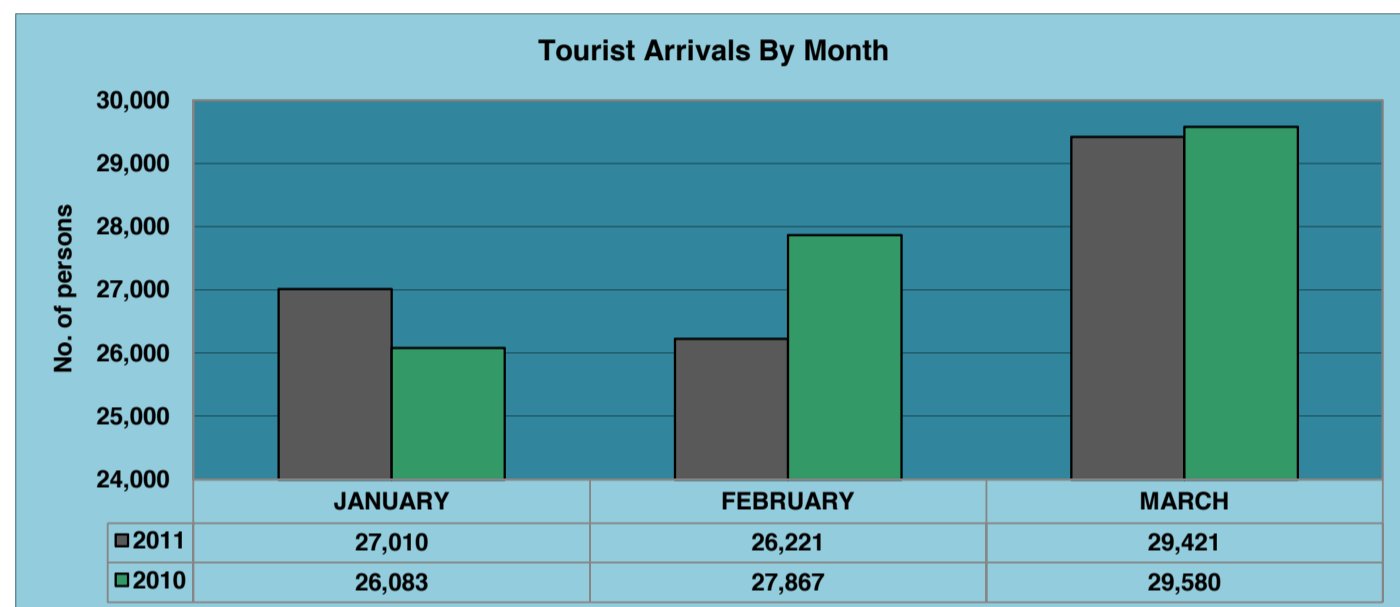
## TOURIST ARRIVALS (MARCH, 2011)
